

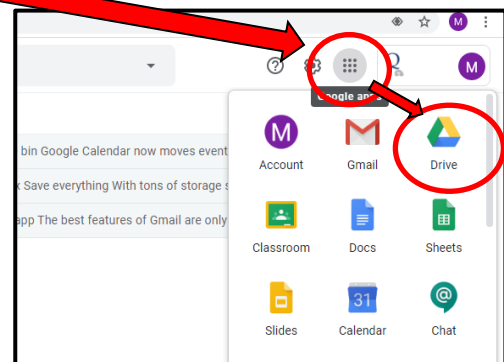
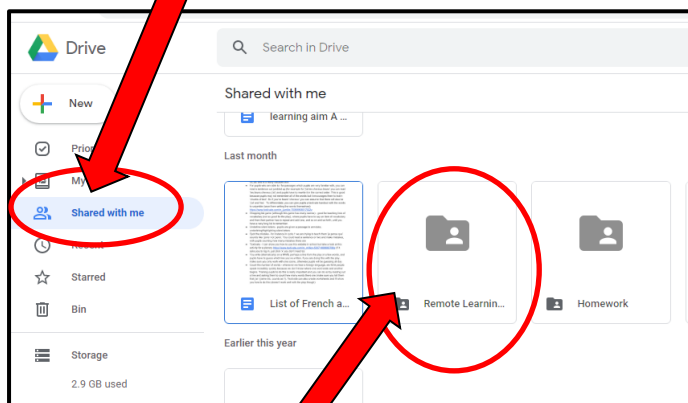
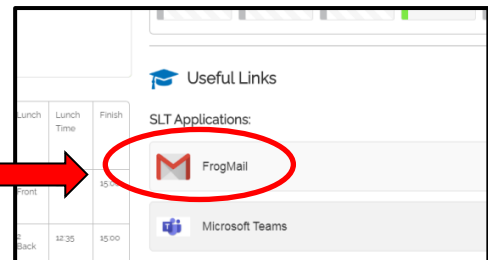
## Remote Learning – Year 9

If you are isolating at home when the rest of your year group is in school, you may be well enough to continue with your lessons from home. In that case you would be expected to:

- (i) follow your normal timetable, completing the Remote Learning lessons in the time you would normally have those subjects;
- (ii) bring your completed work back to school when you return.

All your work can be found in the **Google Drive**:

1. Go to the **school website** and log into **Frog**
2. Click on **FrogMail**
3. Click on the **Google apps** icon and then click **Drive**
4. Go to **Shared with me**



5. Click on the **Remote Learning** folder to find your work.

Your work for each subject will be set in one of the following ways:

1. A **block of work** to complete, no matter when you are off school in the cycle
2. **Work for each date/week** of the cycle. (For example, if you are absent in Week 4, you should complete the Week 4 work, but if you are absent in Week 8, you should complete the Week 8 work.)
3. You will receive **an email** from your teacher.

**If you have any questions, you should email your teacher.**

Use the table below to help you understand what each of your teachers is expecting you to do when you would normally be in their lessons:

<b>For these subjects, you should complete the two week block of work:</b>	Dance English French History Music
<b>For these subjects, you should complete the work for the correct school week:</b>	Art Computer Science Drama DT Food and Nutrition Geography Literacy Maths PE RE
<b>You will receive an email from your teacher:</b>	Science
